Letter dated 11 January 2012 from the Permanent Representative of the United Arab Emirates to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to transmit herewith the second annual report of the Office for the Coordination of Foreign Aid of the United Arab Emirates,* which contains data and analysis regarding foreign aid provided by the United Arab Emirates in 2010. Such aid totalled 2.80 billion United Arab Emirates dirhams, or 762,200,000 United States dollars, in the form of donations and loans for charitable development and humanitarian programmes in over 120 countries around the world. The Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) is also seized of the document.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the sixty-sixth session of the General Assembly under agenda item 18.
