
#### Sendai Initiative of Japan


4 billion US\$ support

→JICA achieved in FY2015-2018

75,109 people trained achieved

#### Sendai Initiative of Japan Phase II

- ✓ Providing support for 5 million people and training/education to 85,000 DRR officials within 4 years (2019-2022)
- ✓ Supporting 80 countries to develop/improve DRR strategies/plans by 2020








