



ECOSOC Special Meeting on International Cooperation in Tax Matters

Join us at the **2024 ECOSOC Special Meeting on International Cooperation in Tax Matters,** which will take place on **Monday, 18 March**, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (New York time).

The Meeting serves as a space **for diverse stakeholders to discuss key international tax issues**, fostering exchange of ideas and advancing intergovernmental deliberation on tax matters.

The **2024 Special Meeting takes on greater significance** given the urgency of collective action to put the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) back on track, strengthen institutions in the context of technological change, and address gaps and weaknesses in the international financial architecture.

The Meeting is expected to make strong contributions to the global discussions in advance of the Financing for Development Forum (22-25 April 2024), the Summit of the Future (22-23 September 2024), and the preparations for the Fourth International Conference on Financing for Development (4FfD) in 2025.

It will also support the follow-up on the recent General Assembly resolution <u>78/230</u> establishing an ad hoc intergovernmental committee mandated to develop draft terms of reference for a United Nations framework convention on international tax cooperation.

This year's Special Meeting will examine **two themes**:

- Promotion of inclusive and effective international tax cooperation at the United Nations; and
- the role of net wealth taxes in promoting equality and financing the SDGs

The Meeting will aim to identify **concrete options** and **effective approaches** for fiscal measures in support of more inclusive and sustainable development and to advance progress toward a fair, inclusive, and effective international tax system.
