1. Indonesia joins other Member States in highlighting **the critical issues** of...

 - monitoring and follow-up to measures the sustainable development goals progress...

2. With **only six years left** to meet the SDGs target...
 - reliable and timely data is critical...
 - to ensure that we can meet the promise of **leaving no one behind**.

3. Having said that... we wish to further **highlight the following points**.

4. **First...** to address data gaps and enhance data quality in developing countries...
 - we need to **scale up investment in national statistic office...**
 - **and capacity building**.

5. Enhancing institutional frameworks and empowering local statisticians... **need to be our priorities.**
6. **International support** is crucial to be bolstered... including through...
 - coordinated efforts among multilateral and regional organizations... as well as
 - fostering South-South cooperation...
 - to exchange expertise and support the national statistic authorities... especially for **SIDS, LDCs, and LLDCs.**
7. **Second... integrated data** is crucial to measure the progress of SDGs.
8. Indonesia has made significant strides in implementing the **Integrated National Financing Framework (INFF)**... that tags our financing strategies with SDGs.
9. Effective data collection system in INFF provides diagnostic analysis and monitoring evaluation.

- It can **identify needs and priorities** on various SDG indicators...
- to help countries **identify critical areas** that require funding...
- ensuring that resources are directed towards the most impactful interventions.

10. **Third...** exploring **various monitoring and data collection platforms**... including but not limited to the **Total Official Support for Sustainable Development**.
11. Utilizing diverse platforms will enhance our ability to gather comprehensive data... track progress effectively... and ensure that we are meeting our goals.
12. **Transparency and accountability are essential** for ensuring that financial commitments are met... and that resources are properly allocated.
13. These follow-up platform will enable better monitoring of progress... facilitate informed decision-making... and promote greater international cooperation and resource mobilization for sustainable development.
