Excellency,

In our capacity as co-facilitators of the outcome document of the Fourth International Conference on Financing for Development (FFD4), we have the honour to share with you the enclosed first draft of the outcome document.

This first draft builds on comments that delegations and stakeholders provided on the zero draft outcome document in the Permanent Representative-level briefing on 22 January 2025, the townhall meeting for stakeholders on 7 February 2025, and the third FFD4 Preparatory Committee session from 10-14 February 2025.

We would like to convey our sincere appreciation for the constructive engagement of all countries and stakeholders, and for their feedback. We made every possible effort to reflect these comments and feedback. We remain committed to facilitating agreement on an ambitious and action-oriented outcome document.

In accordance with the negotiation roadmap circulated on 17 January 2025, we will continue to consult with Member States and groups prior to the first intersessional negotiations. The first draft will be presented during a Permanent Representative-level meeting on Monday, 24 March 2025 at 3 pm in Conference Room 4 at United Nations Headquarters in New York, which will mark the start of the first intersessional. The intersessional, which will conclude on 4 April 2025, will be followed by informal informals and consultations, as needed. The fourth session of the Preparatory Committee will take place from 30 April to 1 May 2025 in New York and will resume for one day in June 2025 to agree on the final outcome document upon the conclusion of negotiations. The updated negotiation roadmap is enclosed for reference.

We look forward to continuing to engage closely with all delegations and stakeholders throughout the process.
