Negotiation roadmap for the outcome document of the Fourth International Conference on Financing for Development (FfD4)

Date	Milestones
17 January 2025	Zero draft circulated.
22 January 2025	PR-level briefing to present the zero draft and roadmap to the membership. Member States present initial reactions to the zero draft.
7 February 2025	Townhall meeting for stakeholders.
10-14 February 2025	The 3rd PrepCom will feature a paragraph by paragraph reading of the zero draft. The zero draft will be projected on the screen, but on-screen edits will not be made. We ask for comments on the ideas and substance in the document, not for language edits.
17 February – 7 March 2025	Updating draft outcome document based on 3 rd PrepCom and PR-level briefing comments. Co-facilitators will continue to engage with delegations and stakeholders.
Week starting 10 March 2025	Draft outcome document circulated.
10-21 March 2025	Period for Member State and group internal consultations.
24 March 2025	First intersessional: PR-level general comments on draft outcome document.
25-28 March 2025, 1-4 April 2025	First intersessional: line-by-line text-based negotiations on draft outcome document. ¹ Compilations will be made available for Member States to consult with capitals following the conclusion of each intersessional. Unattributed compilations will be sent to stakeholders.
7-11; 22-25 April 2025	Pause in negotiations, for Member States and groups internal consultations.
30 April – 1 May 2025	4th PrepCom part one: the session will be paused at the conclusion of the second day.
2 May 2025	Second intersessional: PR-level general comments on draft outcome document.
5-9 May 2025	Second intersessional: line-by-line text-based negotiations on draft outcome document.
12-23 May 2025	Informal informals, as needed, and Member States and group internal consultations.
27-30 May 2025	Third intersessional: line-by-line text-based negotiations on draft outcome document.
Mid-June 2025	4th PrepCom part two: reaching consensus on outcome document.

¹ Intersessional negotiations on Domestic Public Resources may benefit from the presence of capital-based officials for the ECOSOC Special Meeting on Tax on 28 March 2025.
