

Entry requirements:

Please be advised that visa application for entering Spain and registration with United Nations for attending the Conference are two separate procedures.

Kindly note that visa requirement must be met before arrival in Spain, visas cannot be issued upon arrival.

Participants are therefore strongly encouraged to check whether they need a visa to enter Spain and to submit the visa application as soon as possible, and preferably at least 5 weeks before the opening of the Conference. Late submission may make it impossible to process the application in time.

In the following link you will find information about countries whose nationals must be in possession of a visa and those whose nationals are exempt from that requirement to enter Spain, together with information about visa processing Offices:
