Excellency,

In our capacity as co-facilitators of the outcome document of the Fourth International Conference on Financing for Development (FFD4), we have the honour to inform you about the finalization of the draft outcome document.

We regret that silence was broken on the revised draft we circulated on 14 June 2025. We have since undertaken further consultations and made some final adjustments with a view to addressing concerns in a manner that maintains the integrity, balance and ambition of the outcome document. We believe this document fulfils our commitment to facilitate consensus on a balanced, ambitious, and action-oriented outcome document. We believe that the implementation of the outcome document will lead to the reform of the international financial architecture, address the cost of borrowing, and scale up investment to close the financing gap for sustainable development.

We will present to the co-chairs of the FFD4 Preparatory Committee our final revised text of the *Compromiso de Sevilla*, attached hereto, which reflects our best efforts to arrive at consensus. In this regard, adjustments to language have been made in paragraphs 15, 27i, 41b, 43g, 43n, 45a, 50f, 65b. This text has been carefully revised to address concerns and priorities, while maintaining its balance and ambition. We believe it represents the best possible outcome that can be endorsed by all Member States at the resumed fourth session of the FFD4 Preparatory Committee taking place Tuesday, 17 June 2025 at 3p.m.

We extend our sincere appreciation to all delegations for their active and constructive engagement and the spirit of compromise and flexibility that has been shown throughout the consultations. We appreciate and thank all delegations for exercising their maximum flexibility and strong commitment to reaching consensus.
